Ribera del Duero 2024 **Special Report** *Top 100*

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Introduction

My annual trip to Ribera del Duero has become an integral part of my wine tasting year. Having just spent two weeks on holiday, I'm at my most relaxed and enthusiastic, very keen to reacquaint myself with one of Spain's most exciting and dynamic wine regions. Visiting vineyards, talking to winemakers and tasting lots of great reds, whites and rosados is a fantastic way to welcome the start of autumn.

Winemakers, by contrast, are not at their most relaxed during harvest. Depending on how complicated the growing season has been – Ribera del Duero has had only one relatively straightforward vintage (2021) in the last five years – this can be a time of significant stress and worry. In some senses, the last thing they need is a wine writer asking questions and looking to taste samples. My apologies to them. I love being in the region at this time – to sample the grapes, look at the state of the vineyards and to take a few photos when the light is so beautiful.

This is the eighth time that I've published a Top 100 at the invitation of the Consejo Regulador, who have always welcomed me to their region with kindness and professionalism. They also allow me to do my job without interference. The final choice of wines is entirely mine. The 13-day, fact-finding visit that I did earlier this year was as intense as ever. All in all, I tasted 551 wines from 173 bodegas, visiting just over half of them in person. I also spent two mornings walking through vineyards with Noelia Callejo of Félix Callejo and the team from Protos.

Ribera del Duero is predominantly a red wine region, of course, with Tempranillo the dominant grape. So it's no surprise that there are 94 tintos in this year's selection.

But it also makes rosés, or claretes – indeed, this was the region's dominant wine style as recently as the 1970s – and, since the 2019 vintage, has included white wines based on the local Albillo Mayor grape under the Denominación de Origen. There are again six very smart whites in this year's Top 100, with several very different styles on offer. Two rosados just failed to make the winners' enclosure.

Ribera del Duero is a famously extreme,

even marginal area, which has one of the shortest growing seasons on the planet. Frosts are not unheard of in June and the harvest is normally completed by mid-October, or earlier in hotter vintages. There is considerable variation from one year to the next, which is as much a strength as a weakness in a fine wine region, where consumers prize quality and an expression of place above consistency. No two vintages are the same.

The four vintages that dominate this year's Top 100 are a case in point. 2022 (27 wines) was very hot and early, 2021 (30 wines) was fresh and comparatively moderate, producing some of the best wines of the last decade, 2020 (27 wines) was more mixed, depending on when people harvested, but has also produced some excellent reds, and 2019 (16 wines) was hot, dry, but balanced, again yielding some outstanding wines. Apart from these four vintages, there are wines from 2023, 2018, 2016 and 2015 in my selection, as well as one nonvintage (CVC in Spanish) red from Vega Sicilia that marries 2011, 2012 and 2013.

All of the wines in the Top 100 scored 94 points or more. One achieved 100 points (the second time that Vega Sicilia has achieved this distinction from me), one scored 98 points and four achieved 97 points. Once again, I was heartened by the ongoing shift in style – at least among the top producers – towards greater elegance, freshness and balance and away from power, alcohol and reliance on colour and oak rather than fruit and acidity. This was especially hard to achieve in the sweltering 2022 vintage and is a tribute to how hard the best bodegas worked in the vineyard.

There has been a degree of evolution, once more, among the bodegas represented in the Top 100. Some producers have been there since

the start – how can you create such a list without Dominio de Es, Dominio de Pingus, Hermanos Pérez Pascuas, Hermanos Sastre and Vega Sicilia, for instance? – but there are additions every year. Notable newcomers in 2024 are Bodegas Bardos, Dominio de Cair, Picón del Barroso and Valderiz. Five of the bodegas that featured for the first time last year are there again: Cuentaviñas, El Lagar de Isilla, Milsetentayseis, Territorio Luthier and Trespiedras Fuentecén. Consistency is a virtue.

The last thing that I would like to highlight again this year is the continuing trend towards village and parcel specific wines. Some of the best Ribera del Dueros are blended across the region – Aalto, Alión, Ausàs, Cuentaviñas and Garmón Continental being top examples – but a growing number reflect individual terroirs and communes. As people learn more about Ribera del Duero, so they will learn to recognise the differences between wines from, say, Anguix, Aranda and Atauta, or Moradillo de Roa, Nava de Roa and Roa itself. The next step will be the recognition of the very best sites, possibly as the equivalent of Burgundy's Grands Crus. For now, this is some way off, but a meaningful map of the region's terroirs is long overdue.

The more information they have, the more consumers and wine specialists will understand the complexity and diversity of Ribera del Duero. What happens in the cellar will always influence the finished wine, but, as estate agents are always telling us, it's location, location, location that really counts.

I hope you enjoy tasting the wines from my 2024 Ribera Top 100 as much as I did selecting them.

Tasting notes Reds



Vega Sicilia Único Reserva Especial (2025 Release) NV Reserva (14%)

Reserva Especial is always a blend of three vintages, released after a decade or more in barrel and bottle when it is beginning to be ready to drink. The 2025 release partners two very good to excellent vintages (2011 and 2012) with one of the wettest in history (2013), but this is so much more than the sum of its parts. In fact, it's one of the great Vega Sicilias. Marrying Tinto Fino and 4% Cabernet Sauvignon, it has layers of sweet spices, tobacco leaf, graphite and liquorice, blackberry and summer berry flavours, granular tannins and an attractive volatile lift. Wine doesn't get any better than this. 2027-45



Vega Sicilia Único 2015

Reserva (14.5%)

Responding to the heat and power of the 2015 vintage, Gonzalo Iturriaga was grateful for the 4% Cabernet Sauvignon in this blend with Tinto Fino. Firmer and denser than the 2014 release, it partners aromas of earth, tobacco leaf and dark chocolate with a palate of Asian spices, ginger, cassis and blackberry and polished tannins. A triumph over the elements. 2028-40



Bodegas Félix Callejo Félix Callejo 2022

Cosecha (14%)

One of the earliest ever harvests in Ribera del Duero, 2022 was a vintage when cooler sites came into their own. This top-of-the-range Tinto Fino uses grapes from two parcels - Medioarroyo and Montecillo - both at 900 metres and is wonderfully perfumed and refined, with rose petal and wet stone aromas, chalky minerality and a core of plum black cherry and summer berry flavours. 2026-40



Bodegas y Viñedos Gallego Zapatero Yotuel Finca de Valdepalacios 2020

Cosecha (15%)

Now 87 years' old, Finca Valdepalacios occupies a gentle, south-facing slope on sandy clay soils. Showing its class and poise in a comparatively hot vintage, this is a complete, wonderfully textured Tinto Fino with impressive freshness for a wine with 15% alcohol. Leather, thyme and fennel aromas segue into a palate that marries subtle reduction, 50% new wood and flavours of fig, bramble and blackberry framed by savoury tannins. 2027-36



Dominio de Pingus Pingus 2022

Cosecha (13.9%)

Great winemakers - and vineyards – often come into their own in challenging vintages. Even Peter Sisseck was "surprised that I could make such a wine in 2022". Sourced from a fourhectare parcel that was established in 1929, it's a nuanced, layered, medium-bodied Pingus with no new oak interference, succulent bramble and red berry flavours, a ferrous undertone, plenty of acidity, fine-boned tannins and a vibrant finish. Almost drinkable now, but will develop further magic in bottle. 2028-38



Sei Solo Bodegas y Viñedos Sei Solo 2021

Cosecha (15%)

The top wine from Sei Solo just seems to get better and better, making the most of a very good vintage in 2021. Sourced from seven different parcels in La Horra, this is an elegant, refined, beautifully judged Tinto Fino from a quality-obsessed winemaker. Framed by subtle oak, it's perfumed and acid-driven with sculpted tannins and a partnership of plum, black cherry fruit and toast. 2026-40



Bodegas El Lagar de Isilla El Lagar de Isilla Vino de Viña Parcela Viña La Torreta Langa de Duero 2021

Cosecha (14%)

My pick of an outstanding range from El Lagar de Isilla in 2021, La Torreta comes from an intensely chalky, old-vine site at 920 metres in Langa de Duero. Deftly wooded in 50% new oak, it has some subtle, stony reduction, thrilling acidity, crafted tannins, liquorice, bramble and redcurrant flavours and the focus and structure to age in bottle. 2026-35



Bodegas Félix Callejo Majuelos 2022

Cosecha (14%)

Majuelos showcases grapes from Sotillo de la Ribera's more marginal soils of sand and stones and is often among the more structured reds in the Félix Callejo range. Dense, firm and grippy, it has stylish 50% new wood, some chalky freshness, cranberry and black cherry fruit, fine tannins and a hint of appealing reduction. 2025-35



Bodegas Garmón Contintental Garmón 2022

Cosecha (14.5%)

Produced in what Eduardo García admits was a "complicated" vintage, the 2022 release of Garmón illustrates the benefits of blending grapes across the region. Using raw material from six different villages in Burgos and Valladolid, this cuvée of Tinto Fino and 7% Cabernet Sauvignon has impressive balance and precision in a hot year. Aged in 25% new French oak, it has good structure and freshness, blackberry, cassis and blood orange flavours, refined tannins and a toasty finish. 2026-35



Bodegas Marta Maté Los Perejiles 2022

Cosecha (14%)

Los Perejilles is the top wine from César Maté, made with Tinto Fino and 5% Albillo Mayor from a 120-year-old parcel at 915 metres in Tubilla del Lago. Fifty per cent whole bunches add notes of clove and tobacco leaf to a palate of wild strawberry, water melon, oregano and pomegranate framed by scented new French oak. Herbal and mineral, it's a wine that confounds your expectations of Ribera del Duero. 2026-40



Bodegas Territorio Luthier 2019

Reserva (15%)

Seventeen parcels in La Vid and Zazuar, all of them over 70 years' old and situated between 900 and 1,000 metres, supply the raw material for Fernando Ortiz's floral, hauntingly ethereal blend of Tempranillo, 15% Garnacha and 3% white grapes. Concrete fermented and oak aged, it has texture, balance and precision, understated oak, a rose petal top note and crunchy strawberry and redcurrant fruit embellished by fine tannins. 2025-35



Bodegas Valdaya Mirum 2022

Cosecha (14%)

Mirum represents everything I love about Ribera del Duero's new wave reds, making the most of a single cool-climate parcel called Las Piedras at 930 metres in Baños de Valdearrados on clay and white chalk soils. Fermented in concrete before ageing in 43% new oak, it has Burgundian perfume and grace, some subtle reduction, wafts of mountain herbs, detailed tannins, amazing freshness and focus and vibrant black cherry and raspberry fruit, 2025-35



Bodegas Valtravieso Valdelobas de Valtravieso 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Previously labelled as VT, this is the second release of what is now Valdelobas de Valtravieso. A superb expression of high-altitude, this is a wine that smells and tastes of chalk. Refined, refreshing and beautifully balanced, it has subtle, perfumed French oak, violet and basil aromas, sculpted tannins and refined black cherry, raspberry and blueberry fruit. One of the wines of a very good vintage. 2026-40



Casa Lebai El Portillo 2021

Cosecha (14%)

"Sapidity" is the name of the winemaking game at Casa Lebai, according to Rodrigo Calvo Arroyo, who makes this foot-trodden blend of Tinto Fino, 10% Graciano and 10% Bobal from a parcel planted in 1936. Aged in old foudres, it's all about purity, perfume and freshness, with savoury tannins, top notes of clove and pepper and intense plum, strawberry and redcurrant fruit. 2025-38



Dominio de Atauta La Roza 2019

Cosecha (15%)

La Roza is Dominio de Atauta's highest and coolest single-parcel wine, located on a northfacing slope at 960 metres. There's something Mediterranean as well as Piedmontese about its structure, showing the density and intensity of its 180 to 190-year-old vines, firm, sinewy tannins, notes of earth, petrichor and thyme, subtle wood integration and a refreshing, tapering finish. 2026-35



Dominio de Atauta San Juan 2019

Cosecha (15%)

I might not agree with Jaime Suárez's description of this wine as "delicate", but there's no denying its impressive quality. Sourced from 0.45 hectares made up of seven different, south-facing parcels, it's serious, spicy and dense, with Nebbiolo-like tannins, a dusting of Mediterranean herbs, chalky energy and classic old-vine concentration. 2026-35



Dominio de Es Carravilla 2023

Cosecha (13.5%)

Tasted as a barrel sample, but already showing considerable class, Carravilla comes from a rare south-facing slope of limestone based soils. Pairing Tinto Fino with 13% Albillo Mayor, it has alluring violet and wet stone aromas, subtle toasty wood, a touch of reduction and racy blackberry and pomegranate fruit. 2025-35



Dominio de Es La Diva 2023

Cosecha (13.2%)

La Diva is consistently one of the best wines in Ribera del Duero, made with a classic prephylloxera blend of Tinto Fino and 3% Albillo Mayor. The finest and most elegant of the single-parcel Dominio de Es reds, it hails from a 0.3-hectare parcel within the Paraje de Valdegatiles and is wonderfully floral, intense and refined. Intensely chalky and refreshing with sinewy tannins, a salty undertone and layers of redcurrant, plum, vanilla and raspberry. 2026-38



Francisco Barona Finca Las Dueñas 2020

Cosecha (15%)

Finca Las Dueñas is the top cuvée from brilliant young winemaker, Francisco Barona, made with Tinto Fino and 25% Bobal and Albillo Mayor from a small parcel planted in 1928 in Anguix. A wine with chalk in its veins, this was fermented with 100% whole bunches before ageing in new French oak. Plush, glossy and intense, it has elements of Pomerol as well as Ribera del Duero, all coffee bean, thyme and liquorice on the nose and cassis, blackberry and a liqueur like note on the palate. Very intense, yet beautifully balanced. 2027-35



Hacienda Monasterio 2020

Reserva (15%)

Carlos de la Fuente upped the portion of Cabernet Sauvignon to 20% in 2020, blending it with Tinto Fino. The result is a very fine expression of one of the best sites in Valladolid. Aromas of graphite, thyme and rosemary lead you into a palate of cassis, sweet spices and red berry fruit, embellished by layered tannins. A Ribera del Duero for lovers of fine claret. 2027-38



Hermanos Sastre Pesus Selección de Pedro y Jesús 2018

Cosecha (15%)

Always among the best and most ambitious wines in the region, Pesus uses grapes from three different vineyards, two of which are over 100 years' old. Pairing Tinto Fino with 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot from a parcel planted in 1983, it's a bold, inky, fleshy, full-bodied style that takes no prisoners. Ripe, smooth and plushly oaked, with flavours of dark chocolate, blackberry and liquorice and beautifully judged tannins. Ages beautifully too. 2026-38



Milsetentayseis Tinto 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

This remarkable Tinto Fino comes from 85 small parcels on clay and mica-rich soils, located between 900 and 1,000 metres in Fuentenebro. Lithe, chiselled, perfumed and ethereal, it's a Ribera del Duero for Pinot Noir or Mencía lovers, with lots of stony minerality, redcurrant, strawberry and pomegranate flavours, subtle 50% new wood and a bright, tapering finish. 2026-35

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Montebaco Parcela Cara Norte 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Now into its seventh iteration - the 2017 was wiped out by frost - Cara Norte has established itself as one of the best, and best value, reds in Ribera del Duero. Sourced from an organically farmed, north-facing site on clay and limestone soils, with ageing in 20% new wood, this superb 2021 release is refined, detailed and refreshing, with redcurrant and pomegranate flavours, subtle wood and filigree tannins. 2025-35



Picón del Barroso 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Picón del Barroso is a spectacular new project from Carlos del Río and Leonora Sisseck, daughter of Peter Sisseck of Dominio de Pingus. The 0.5-hectare parcel that supplies the grapes was planted as recently as 2017, but it's the La Horra terroir that's the key here. A whole bunch co-fermentation of Tinto Fino and 25% Garnacha, with ageing in older oak, this is floral, focused, refined and self-confident, with a nice interplay between red cherry and pomegranate fruit, sculpted tannins and the acidity that's a feature of the best 2021s. 2026-35



Vega Sicilia Valbuena 5 2020

Reserva (14%)

The 2020 Valbuena all comes from the Vega Sicilia estate and is a blend of Tinto Fino and 3% Merlot from vines close to the river. Gonzalo Iturriaga uses 70% new wood here, 15% of it American, but then switches to older foudres. Floral and elegant, partly because of the 100mm of rain in September, it's a focused, comparatively forward red with bramble, red cherry and blackberry fruit, scented oak spices, a hint of rocket and a refined, tapering finish. 2026-40



Vivaltus Vivaltus 2020

Cosecha (14%)

The 2020 Vivaltus contains no Cabernet Sauvignon - for the first time - so is a blend of Tinto Fino and 3% Merlot. This is also the maiden vintage that uses amphora as well as 5% new French oak ageing. Never a blockbuster, this is a wine that charms rather than overwhelms you. Detailed, ethereal and effortlessly harmonious, it has layers of fresh herbs, cassis, bramble and raspberry, sculpted tannins and a graceful, tapering finish. 2026-40



Abadía de San Quirce Los Libros 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Los Libros is a fantastic new, 500-bottle release from Abadia de San Quirce that takes the bodega to a new quality level. Made with old-vine fruit from a 70-year-old parcel on stone and clay soils in La Aguilera, it's structured yet refined, with savoury tannins, lots of zip and energy, bramble and red berry fruit, notes of mint and Asian spices and a balsamic undertone. Very complex. 2026-40



Ausàs Interpretación 2022

Cosecha (15%)

Produced in what Xavier Ausàs calls the "corpulent" 2022 vintage, this well-judged Tinto Fino from Gumiel de Mercado, Moradillo de Roa and Nava de Roa manages to avoid heatrelated excess. Floral, scented and sweetly oaked, it's a plush, glossy style with a dab of dark chocolate and patisserie spices, flavours of liquorice, clove and blackberry and finely judged tannins. 2026-36



Bodegas Briego 2019

Gran Reserva (14.7%)

A superb follow up to the delicious 2016 release, this is a blend of Tinto Fino grapes from high-altitude Fompedraza with 25% from much lower Peñafiel. Curated in 60% new wood, this is bright, perfumed and refined, with filigree tannins, chalky intensity, bramble, wild strawberry and black cherry fruit and a lingering finish. 2025-38



Bodegas El Lagar de Isilla El Lagar de Isilla Vino de Viña Parcela La Sabina San Juan del Monte 2021

Cosecha (14%)

La Sabina is a single-parcel blend of Tinto Fino and 5% co-planted Albillo Mayor that's produced in small quantities. Entirely foot-trodden after destemming, it's sappy, scented, ethereal and very lightly wooded, with the effortless concentration of its 102-year-old vines and layers of pomegranate and black cherry. 2025-35



Bodegas Hermanos Pérez Pascuas Pérez Pascuas 2019

Gran Reserva (14.5%)

2019 was Nuria Peña Albillo's first vintage at Pérez Pascuas, and she started with a bang. Powerful, inky, dense and made with both eyes on the medium to long term, it's a Ribera del Duero that will appeal to lovers of classic Left Bank Bordeaux, with a spine of tannin and acidity, flavours of damson, black cherry and patisserie spices and a balsamic undertone. 2029-40



Bodegas Hermanos Pérez Pascuas Viña Pedrosa 2019

Gran Reserva (14.5%)

One of those wines that will reward patience, this is just beginning to get into its stride at five years of age. Three different fincas - Cerro Viejo, Carraguzmán an Fuentenogal - contribute the raw material here, benefitting from old vine concentration. Savoury, firm, herbal and lightly balsamic, with a hint of green pepper, spicy French and American oak and impressive concentration. 2027-40



Bodegas La Horra Corimbo I 2019

Reserva (14.5%)

Showing the structure and balance that are the hallmarks of the best 2019s in Ribera del Duero, this impressive Tinto Fino from Miriam Marchena uses old-vine grapes from Anguix, La Horra and Roa. Deeply coloured, scented and vibrant, with sweetly spiced French and 20% American oak, intense black cherry and blueberry fruit, savoury tannins and bright, refreshing acidity. 2025-34



Bodegas Marta Maté Marta Maté 2021

Cosecha (14%)

Marta Maté's eponymous red is a blend of Tinto Fino and 5% Albillo Mayor that uses raw material from 30 parcels in the parajes of Chaval, Malacuera and Valgordo in Tubilla del Lago. Alluringly scented and refreshing, it's a Burgundy lover's Ribera del Duero, marrying aromas of thyme, fennel and pine needles with a touch of reduction and a palate of liquorice, bramble and wild strawberry. Delicious. 2025-35



Bodegas Marta Maté Radical 2022

Cosecha (14.8%)

Previously sold as Raspón, Radical is a small production Tinto Fino that's entirely fermented with whole bunches. Mixing grapes from Malacuera and Fuentelirio in Tubilla del Lago, it's a classic, cooler climate Ribera, with white pepper and tobacco leaf aromas and a palate of fennel, pomegranate and wild strawberry complemented by savoury tannins. 2025-35



Bodegas Monteabellón Finca La Blanquera 2020

Cosecha (14.5%)

La Blanquera is a viewing point as well as vineyard, blessed with one of the most spectacular sites in Burgos. White with chalk - hence its name in Spanish - it's a wine with energy, focus and freshness, all mouth-watering minerality, blueberry and black cherry fruit, subtle oak integration, creamy vanilla oak and a taut, chiselled finish. 2026-35



Bodegas Territorio Luthier Hispania Tinto 2016

Gran Reserva (14.5%)

One of the only wines at Territorio Luthier that's made with a single variety - Tinto Fino in this case, Hispania is entirely aged in Spanish oak. Sourced from a 90-year-old parcel in La Horra, it has a slightly resinous top note, aromas of pine needle and oregano, plenty of red-fruited concentration and a fresh, acid-driven finish. Intriguing. 2025-35



Bodegas Trus Punto Geodésico 2021

Cosecha (15%)

Four separate vineyards, all located on points of natural energy, in the villages of Baños de Valdearados, La Aguilera, Moradillo de Roa and Peñaranda, supply the fruit for this complex, serious, ageworthy Tinto Fino. Lightly wooded in 20% new oak, it has plenty of colour, blackberry and blood orange flavours, refreshing acidity and a firm backbone of tannin. 2025-35



Bodegas y Viñedos Gallego Zapatero Yotuel Finca La Nava 2019

Cosecha (15%)

Finca La Nava is the most limestone rich of Gallego Zapatero's array of single parcel wines and the hardest to make according to Béquer Prieto because of its very small berries. The result has aromas of mountain herbs, hints of liquorice and leather, ample concentration and depth, spicy dark berry fruit and chalky freshness on the finish. 2026-33



Bodegas y Viñedos Gallego Zapatero Yotuel Finca San Miguel 2018

Cosecha (14.5%)

Normally one of the most structured wines in the portfolio, this is a little lighter and more forward because of the higher yields of the more Atlantic 2018 vintage. Sourced from a cool, north-facing, old-vine parcel, it has perfumed 80% new wood, notes of dried coconut and garrigue, spicy tannins, good focus and palate length and succulent plum and summer berry flavours. 2025-32



Casa Lebai Matadiablos 2021

Cosecha (13.5%)

Matadiablos comes from a cool, north-facing parcel within the Paraje de Aguachar in Gumiel de Mercado that was planted with a massal selection from La Nava and El Portillo in 1997. Fermented in open lagars in a semi carbonic maceration style, it's vibrant, ethereal and energetic, with haunting goji berry and pomegranate flavours and hints of clove and tobacco leaf. Deliciously drinkable. 2025-38



Conde de San Cristóbal Oydor 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Oydor is the icon red from Conde de San Cristóbal, produced from a 0.5-hectare plot of old vines within the Paraje Peñalamiel in Quintana del Pidio. More elegant than the 2020 release, it's a youthful, balanced, complex, acid-driven Tinto Fino with layers of dark chocolate, violet, black cherry and plum, fine-grained tannins and impressive underlying tannins. 2026-35



Cuentaviñas Tinto Fino 2022

Cosecha (14%)

This is the second release of a Ribera del Duero from Rioja-based winemaker Eduardo Eguren. Sourced from five villages - Esgueva, Gumiel de Mercado, Pedrosa, Quintana Mamvirgo and Roa, it's fresher than the 2021, despite the heat of the vintage, with stylish 30% new oak, engaging focus and freshness, layers of violet, plum and black cherry and a mineral core. 2026-35



Dominio Basconcillos Viña Magna 2021

Reserva (15.5%)

A Ribera del Duero for lovers of fine Left Bank claret, this is a classic expression of a wonderful vintage from Ángel Calleja that pairs Tinto Fino, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 5% Malbec. Curated in new French oak, it has appealing scents of mocha, dark chocolate and blackcurrant leaf and a palate of liquorice, blueberry and plum supported by fresh acidity and granular tannins. 2026-40



Cosecha (14.5%)

No fewer than 19 different micro-parcels make up the 1.39 hectares of Llanos del Almendro, with an age of between 140 and 150 years' old. Serious, firm and compact, it's among the firmest and most concentrated reds in Dominio de Atauta's range. Mid-way between a Barolo and Ribera del Duero in style, with grippy tannins, notes of liquorice, tar and damson and plenty of supporting acidity. 2026-35



Dominio de Atauta Valdegatilles 2019

Cosecha (15%)

A Ribera del Duero that could only come from the high-altitude, pre-phylloxera vineyards of the picturesque Atauta Valley, this has wonderful mountain herb aromas, effortless concentration and the cool elegance of its north-facing site. Profound and intense, with top notes of lavender and pine needles, layered tannins, energetic acidity and plum and blackberry fruit. Built to last. 2026-32



Dominio de Cair Cruz del Pendón 2022

Cosecha (14.5%)

Three old-vine parcels in La Aguilera - Eustasio, La Cruz Vieja and Nava Vieja - planted with Tinto Fino and bits and pieces of other red varieties are the source of this focused, poised, chalky red. Thyme and lavender aromas segue into a palate that's focused, deeply coloured and nuanced, with plum, fennel and blackberry fruit and sinewy tannins. 2026-38



Dominio de Cair Las Matillas La Esencia 2022

Cosecha (14%)

An impressive follow-up to the previous two releases in 2019 and 2020, Las Matillas is a beautifully balanced cuvée of Tinto Fino and 5% Albillo Mayor from a cool, 94-year-old site of the same name. Fermented in cement before ageing in older barrels, it has thyme and pine needle aromas, a touch of subtle reduction, succulent bramble and summer berry fruit and a hint of wood spices. 2025-32



Dominio del Aguila Peñas Aladas 2018

Gran Reserva (14%)

Peñas Aladas is a 4.5-hectare parcel in one of the coldest parts of La Aguilera, which is prone to frost damage. Jorge Monzón's holdings are divided up into more than 15 sub-parcels and are planted with Tinto Fino and 10% of other mixed varieties. Aged in old wood for five years and a further six months in bottle, this is serious, concentrated stuff, with muscular, Barolo-like tannins from 100% whole bunch fermentation, a slight volatile lift, notes of oregano, tar and sweet spices and a core of damson, forest floor and black cherry. 2025-32



Dominio del Aguila 2020

Reserva (14%)

Sourced from over one hundred different old-vine parcels in La Aguilera - Jorge Monzón uses more than 400 of them in total - this is a whole bunch fermented cuvée of Tinto Fino and 5% other varieties. Serious, firm and structured, with aromas of pepper, iodine, oregano and pine needles, this is grippy and intense, with flavours of fig, damson and blood orange and a dusting of sweet spices. 2026-35

Dominio Fournier 2020

Reserva (14.5%)

Sourced from vineyards close to the Duero River in Berlangas de Roa, this is the best Reserva yet from this González-Byass-owned operation. Fresh, silky and acid-driven, it has layers of bramble, raspberry and black cherry fruit, hints of Asian spices, chocolate and tobacco leaf, adroitly integrated 50% new oak and a stony, refreshing finish. 2026-36

Francisco Barona 2022

Cosecha (15%)

"Mediterranean" is how Francisco Barona describes the torrid conditions in 2022. Reflecting his hard work in the vineyards, this comes from 11 different old-vine parcels in Anguix, La Aguilera, La Horra and Roa and is a skilfully judged blend of Tinto Fino and 25% Garnacha, Bobal, Albillo Mayor and Jaen. Bold, intensely coloured and aged in new French oak, it has layers of plum, blackberry and sweet spices, glossy tannins and added complexity from 20% whole bunches. 2027-35



Hacienda Solano Finca Peña Lobera 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Peña Lobera comes from a wonderful single parcel of 0.6 hectares, planted in 1920 on sand and limestone soils. Fine, elegant and ethereal, it has top notes of rose petal, thyme and hot stones, flavours of raspberry, plum, blood orange and pomegranate, fine-grained tannins, refreshing acidity and a chalky flourish. 2025-35



Legaris Gumiel de Mercado 2021

Cosecha (15%)

Gumiel de Mercado is located in one of the highest parts of viticultural Burgos at 910 metres of altitude. This is still a youngster - the best 2021s need time - but has the structure, perfume and intensity to develop convincingly in bottle. Aromas of chocolate and mountain herbs lead you into a palate of damson, redcurrant and fig with impressive underlying energy. 2027-37



M. Chapoutier España Dominio del Soto Camino Gumiel 2022

Cosecha (14.5%)

Camino Gumiel is a beautiful, isolated vineyard at 900 metres in Sotillo de la Ribera surrounded by holm oaks. Thyme, rosemary and oregano aromas are a scented introduction to a wine of wonderful complexity, with notes of garrigue, black olive, plum and liquorice, chalky freshness and fine-boned tannins. 2026-32

Magna Vides Bancales del Sardal 2022

Cosecha (14%)

My pick of the 2022 vintage releases from Andrea Sanz and Pablo Arranz, this is a very small volume blend of just 300 litres made from a combination of Tinto Fino and 25% Albillo Mayor. Floral, perfumed and complex, with the white grapes adding some much-needed acidity in 2022, this is sappy, fine and detailed, with vanilla spicy new wood, redcurrant, cherry and raspberry fruit and refined tannins. 2025-37



Pago de los Capellanes Doroteo 2019

Cosecha (15.5%)

Named after Doroteo Romero, the founder of the bodega, this pure Tinto Fino comes from a 102-year-old parcel close to the bodega in Pedrosa de Duero. The 25% new wood is slightly less marked than on some of the Pago de los Capellanes reds, which is no bad thing. Aromas of dark chocolate and mountain herbs segue into a palate of fine-grained tannins and scented plum and blueberry fruit. 2027-35

Well up to the standards of its superb predecessors, Acediano comes from a single, 61-yearold parcel on the border between Nava de Roa and Valdezate. Youthful yet well balanced, this has plenty of colour, dark berry fruit and acidity, top notes of mocha and dark chocolate, savoury tannins, a thread of chalky minerality and a structured, ageworthy finish. 2025-32



Trespiedras Fuentecén Unanimous Finca La Maricana 2021

New to the impressive range from Jorge Juan Arandilla and consultant Béquer Prieto, Finca Maricana comes from a 1.04-hectare parcel of the same name on the border between Haza and Fuentecén. Pairing Tinto Fino, 35% Garnacha and 5% Albillo Mayor, it's a complex, lightly wooded delight, with mountain herb and potpourri aromas, thrilling freshness, precision and minerality, pomegranate and redcurrant flavours and fine-boned tannins. Very exciting. 2027-38



Valdemonjas Abrí Las Alas 2022

Cosecha (15%)

Exhibiting the concentration and intensity that you often find in wines from La Horra, Abrí Las Alas comes from an 85-year-old parcel called El Nogal de La Valera. The alcohol is higher than normal because of the heat of the growing season, but this has plenty of structure and backbone, well-handled 50% new wood, damson, cranberry and blackberry fruit and a firm, muscular finish. 2026-35



Viñedos Alonso del Yerro María de Alonso del Yerro 2021

Cosecha (14%)

María is an equal blend of the two best vineyards on the property - El Circo and Violeta located on different soil types. Curated in 25% new wood, this is typically well balanced and self-assured, with engaging violet and rose petal aromas, stylish 25% new French oak, a touch of chalky freshness and flavours of blackberry and pomegranate. 2027-40



Viñedos y Bodegas Áster Finca El Otero 2021

Cosecha (15.5%)

Finca El Otero comes from a 7.5-hectare parcel of the same name in Anguix and is Áster's top of the range red. There's some much needed chalky freshness here, giving a lift to a palate that's firm, dense, concentrated and built to last. Bramble, toast, liquorice and dark plum flavours are complemented by notes of mocha and coffee bean from 100% new French oak. Classy, but needs time. 2027-35



Viñedos y Bodegas García Figuero Milagros Figuero 2021 Cosecha (14%)

Milagros is a superb Tinto Fino from the talented winemaking team of Óscar Rodríguez and Jean-François Hébrard. Showcasing the quality of the Paraje del Camino do los Frailes in the southern part of La Horra, it's wonderfully scented and alluring, with refined 50% new French oak, layered tannins, plum and blackberry fruit and the ferrous undertone that's typical of many reds from the village. 2026-38



Viñedos y Bodegas García Figuero Tinus 2022

Cosecha (14%)

Tinus is a single vineyard wine from Malasmañas, located in the northern part of La Horra below the Monte de Villalobón. Showing impressive freshness in what was a very hot vintage, this has sappy black cherry, tangerine and blueberry fruit flavours, toasty 50% new wood and more than enough acidity to lift and lengthen the finish. 2027-40



Aalto Bodegas y Viñedos Aalto 2022

Cosecha (15%)

Aalto is one of the leading and most successful examples of a pan-Ribera del Duero Tempranillo, using grapes from 200 parcels in nine different villages across the Denominación de Origen. Skilfully blended by Antonio Moral, this has sweet vanilla and cigar box aromas from 50% new wood, lots of colour and intensity, Asian spice, chocolate, plum and black cherry flavours and supporting acidity. 2025-38



Aalto Bodegas y Viñedos Aalto PS 2022

Cosecha (15%)

PS retails at nearly three times the price of the regular Aalto release, and uses grapes from the contrasting villages of La Aguilera, La Horra and Baños de Valdearados. Inky, powerful, concentrated and lavishly wooded in 100% new oak, this is a wine that's constructed for the long haul, like a Bordeaux First Growth, with layers of dark chocolate, fig and damson and muscular tannins. 2027-40



Alión 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

The latest in a commendably consistent run of Alión releases, this varietal Tinto Fino uses raw material from around 300 different parcels in Burgos, Valladolid and Soria. Matured in a combination of French and 5% American wood, as well as foudres and concrete, this is a very elegant red that reflects the cooler 2021 vintage. Violet and green herb aromas are complemented by a palate of plum and black cherry, fine-grained tannins and a persistent, mineral-edged finish. 2025-32



Bodegas Arzuaga Navarro Reserva Especial 2019

Reserva (14.6%)

Arzuaga Navarro's impressive Reserva Especial combines Tinto Fino and 3% Albillo Mayor from old vine parcels in the higher part of Burgos. Modern, stylish and intense, with ageing in new French oak barrels, this has aromas of coffee bean and liquorice, fine-grained tannins and layers of blackberry and tangerine. 2027-35



Bodegas Bardos Villálvaro 2022

Cosecha (14.5%)

Villálvaro in Soria is the source of this bush-vine red, located at 940 metres. Aged in a second-use foudre to preserve freshness and perfume, this is more Mediterranean in style than the other Bardos reds, with some lift from 2% Garnacha and Albillo Mayor. Thyme and lavender aromas lead you into a subtle, layered, red-fruited palate with fine-boned tannins and a stony finish. 2025-35

Among the best recent releases of Infiel, this is made with grapes from a 60-year-old parcel in Aranda de Duero. Bodegas Hermanos Pérez Pascuas Finca La Navilla 2021

Reserva (14.5%)

La Navilla hails from vineyards around the bodega in Pedrosa de Duero and is a field blend of 99% Tinto Fino and a smidgeon of other red and white grapes. Aged entirely in French oak, this has the structure and weight of its south-facing exposition, with notes of wild herbs, blackberry liqueur and incense, firm, but well-integrated tannins and balancing acidity. 2027-38

Bodegas Territorio Luthier Hispania 2021

Aged in Spanish oak, otherwise known as Quercus Pyrenaica, this is a part of a very individual and consistently impressive range from Territorio Luthier. Made with a cofermentation of Tinto Fino, 15% Garnacha and 3% Albillo Mayor, it has lovely flavours of wild herbs, blackberry and tapenade, aromatic wood spices, a twist of white pepper and sinewy

Pico de Luyas shines the spotlight on two parcels in the very different Burgos villages of Roa and Peñaranda de Duero and is a beautiful expression of the new, less oaky style at Bodegas Trus. Bodegas Valdaya 2022

Matured in 25% new wood, it carries its 14.5% alcohol lightly, showing good acidity for a 2022, chalky minerality and tangy pomegranate and strawberry fruit. 2025-32



Bodegas Valtravieso Finca La Atalaya 2021

Reserva (14.5%)

Not so long ago, Valtravieso's plantings at 900 metres in Piñel de Arriba were regarded as marginal in cooler vintages, but not anymore because of global warming. This is a superb assemblage of Tinto Fino and 25% Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot that would appeal to lovers of old-fashioned claret. Violet, coffee bean and fresh mint aromas are complemented by fine tannins, cassis and blackberry flavours and finely judged tannins. 2025-38



Bodegas Valtravieso Vino de Finca 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Vino de Finca comes from three separate parcels above 900 metres in Piñel de Arriba - El Cotarro, El Lobón and Finca La Revilla - and illustrates the class of the 2021 vintage. Pairing Tinto Fino and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, it has engaging aromas of mint and blackcurrant leaf, some subtle reduction, understated oak and layers of coffee bean, plum and blueberry fruit. Beautifully balanced. 2025-32



Bodegas Vizcarra Celia 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Named after one of Juan Carlos Vizcarra's daughters, Celia is a blend of Tinto Fino and Garnacha from a parcel that was planted in 1946. Using a combination of foudres and 60% new wood, this is an intensely perfumed assemblage, with subtle oak handling, a spine of tannin and acidity, a waft of violet and a core of plum, bramble and blackberry fruit. Serious stuff that will reward cellaring. 2027-38



Bodegas Vizcarra Inés 2021

Cosecha (14.5%)

Inés is an unusual blend of Tinto Fino, 7% Merlot and 2% Albillo Mayor and is one of two wines to bear the name of Juan Carlos Vizcarra's daughters. Firm, compact and built to last, this has a subtle green herb note, serious dark berry fruit, notes of chocolate and coffee bean and the focus that's typical of the vintage. 2026-35

Conde de San Cristóbal Reserva Especial 2022

Reserva (14.5%)

"Elegantly powerful" is the paradox that Xavier Ausàs uses to describe the best wines from the challenging 2022 vintage. This pure Tinto Fino hails from four different parcels within the La Calvacha paraje and is the most Bordeaux-like of the Conde de San Cristóbal reds. Matured in 50% new French oak, it has a nice combination of grip and texture, with layers of cassis, blackberry and coffee bean and supporting acidity. 2025-38



Dominio de Cair Pendón de La Aguilera 2022

Cosecha (14.5%)

Priced above Cruz del Pendón, but not showing quite as well at the moment, this is a dense, firm, intensely perfumed assemblage of mostly Tinto Fino with Benedicto, Palo Alto, Garnacha and Bobal from two parcels in La Aguilera - Águila and Carrevilla - planted in 1928 and 1920, respectively. Flavours of orange peel, plum, liquorice and blackberry combine impressively on the palate, supported by serious tannins. Give it time. 2027-36



Dominio de Es La Mata 2023

Cosecha (13%)

La Mata is a cooler, east-facing, pre-phylloxera parcel of 0.4 hectares at 935 metres. Aged in new oak, it's a dense, compact, youthful blend of Tinto Fino, 9% Albillo Mayor and 7% Alicante Bouschet with ample concentration and presence, chewy tannins, layers of damson, fennel and blueberry and enough acidity to lift and freshen the finish. 2027-35



Dominio de Pingus Flor de Pingus 2022

Cosecha (13.8%)

Flor accounts for 90% of the production of Pingus and uses Tinto Fino grapes from 40 hectares of vineyards with an average age of 25 years in the village of La Horra. Commendably refined and floral in a very hot vintage, partly thanks to early picking, this is youthful, appealing and alluring, with nice tension and freshness, deftly integrated 20% new oak and flavours of plum, pomegranate and red cherry. 2026-34



Familia Fernández Rivera Tinto Pesquera Millenium Gran

Reserva 2019

Gran Reserva (15%)

Millenium is the most international in style of the Tinto Pesquera reds, with ageing in 30% new wood. Sourced from the semi-páramo vineyards between 700 and 900 metres, this won't be released for another year, and that's probably a good thing. Dense, firm, yet showing underlying freshness, it has damson and red berry flavours, plenty of chalky minerality and muscular tannins. 2026-40

Legaris Alcubilla de Avellaneda 2021

Cosecha (15%)

Some of Soria's vineyards are over 150 years' old, so this parcel, planted in 2004, is a relative youngster. Picked late because of its 926 metres of altitude, it combines aromas of clove, fennel and lavender with a palate of earthy red fruits, firm, savoury tannins, subtle French and American oak integration and a balanced, refreshing finish. 2026-35

Mélida Wines Eternauta 2023

Cosecha (14%)

"A different style of Ribera del Duero" is how Fernando Valenti describes Eternauta, made with very old vine parcels from high-altitude Quintana del Pidio and Baños de Valdearados. Fermented with 40% whole bunches, it has notes of pepper and tobacco leaf, racy acidity, bramble and pomegranate fruit and subtle oak integration. Still young, but already appealing. 2026-32

Montebaco Selección Especial 2019

Cosecha (14.5%)

Made by the late César Muñoz, one of Ribera's greatest winemakers, this is a pan-regional red that uses grapes from Pesquera de Duero in Valladolid and Baños de Valdearados in Burgos. The most classic wine in the Montebaco range, it has lovely plum and black cherry fruit, plenty of chalky minerality, spicy wood and a balsamic twist. 2026-38



Pago de los Capellanes Parcela El Nogal 2020

Cosecha (15.5%)

El Picón sells at a higher price, but I slightly prefer the current release of its stablemate, El Nogal. Ripe and plush, as the bodega's wines tend to be, but the 15.5% alcohol is well integrated here, framed by scented 50% new oak and supported by serious, concentrated damson, plum and blackberry fruit. 2027-35



Pago de los Capellanes Parcela El Picón 2019

Cosecha (15.5%)

El Picón is the icon wine from Pago de los Capellanes, sourced from a 1.7-hectare parcel that was planted in Pedrosa de Duero in 1978. Very modern in style, with 30% new wood and malolactic in barrel, it has considerable concentration, power and structure, aromas of mocha, lavender and Asian spices, layers of bramble, blackberry and blueberry fruit and the structure and acidity to age well. 2025-35



Quinta Milú El Malo 2023

Cosecha (14%)

El Malo used to be a single parcel wine but now uses grapes from four old vineyards: Bellavista, Calvario, La del Paco and La Selva. Fermented with 25% whole bunches in a semicarbonic maceration style, it's a typically intense, concentrated Tinto Fino with top notes of incense, potpourri and mint, a classic palate of damson and black cherry and attractive oak integration. Needs more time. 2027-38



Valdemonjas Los Tres Dones 2022

Cosecha (15%)

For the second vintage in succession, Alejandro and Alexis Moyano blended grapes from Valdemonjas' Quintanilla de Arriba base with a 25% component from La Horra to produce Los Tres Dones. Aged in 30% new French oak, is has top notes of mint, fennel and stony reduction, lots of colour and grip and appealing bramble and blackberry fruit. Will reward cellaring. 2025-35



Valderiz Tomás Esteban 2018

Cosecha (14.5%)

Any wine that features a photograph by the late Catalan photographer Ramón Masats is alright by me. But what lies behind the label in 2018 is pretty special, too. This is a blend of three centenary parcels in different parts of Roa, combining mostly Tinto Fino with Albillo Mayor and other varieties. Built to last, it has impressive density and weight, scented cedarwood top notes, fine tannin and layers of damson, cassis and blueberry fruit. 2027-40



Viñedos y Bodegas García Figuero Pago de Torrosillo 2022

Cosecha (14%) Pago de Torrosillo is the new n

Pago de Torrosillo is the new name for what used to be sold as Noble and hails from a parcel of the same name at 840 metres in La Horra. The 50% new oak is quite marked here, but there is more than enough concentration and fruit weight to soak it up. Ripe, fleshy and showing the texture of a hot year, it has underlying chalky freshness, flavours of blueberry and orange zest and a mineral finish. 2026-35



Yllera Bodegas y Viñedos Meraldis 2020

Cosecha (14%)

Meraldis is a bit of an outlier at Yllera, as it was fermented with 50% whole bunches and contains no Bordeaux grapes. Old vine parcels in Anguix, Atauta, Fuentenebro, La Aguilera and Moradillo de Roa supply the grapes here, producing an elegant, restrained Tinto Fino with redcurrant and pomegranate flavours, well-integrated new French oak and a hint of good reduction. 2025-30

Based on Albillo Mayor, as Ribera del Duero whites have to be, with lesser contributions from Malvasía Blanca, Pirulés and Viura, this is a thrilling cuvée from Fernando Ortiz. Alluring aromas of mint, saffron and wild mountain herbs lead you into a still youthful palate that's toasty, layered and complex, mixing flavours of quince, orange peel and sweet spices and impressive underlying structure. 2024-32



Bodegas Vizcarra Alejandra 2022

Cosecha (13%)

First made in 2018, Alejandra is a varietal Albillo Mayor that uses white vines that were coplanted in red vineyards over 70 years' ago. Fermented in concrete before ageing in older 225 and 500-litre barrels, this is the best release yet from Juan Carlos Vizcarra. Floral, mealy and refreshing, with notes of citrus peel and rock salt, a touch of cream and a long, bone-dry finish. 2026-32



Bodegas Arzuaga Navarro Gran Vino Blanco de Guarda 2016 Gran Reserva (13%)

Arzuaga were making great Albillo Mayors before they were recognised as white Ribera del Dueros by the Consejo Regulador. This superb example from small plots in Anguix, Baños de Valdearados, Gumiel de Izan and Roa was fermented and aged in barrel for 61 months before bottling. Leesy, toasty and waxy, it has layers of spice, citrus and wet stones and a drizzle of honey. 2025-32



Dominio del Pidio Albillo Mayor 2023

Cosecha (13%)

Always among the leading examples of white Ribera del Duero, this pure Albillo Mayor sees an equal combination of cement tanks and new French oak. Fennel, vanilla and petrichor aromas are a scented introduction to a palate of struck match, citrus peel and a touch of cream. Complex, layered and long on the palate. 2024-28



M. Chapoutier España Dominio del Soto Albillo Mayor 2023

Crianza (12.7%)

Farmed biodynamically, this Albillo Mayor comes from comparatively young, ten-yearold vines in Gumiel de Mercado, this is the weightier and more concentrated of the two Chapoutier whites, with sensitive ageing in 50% new barrels. Jasmine and thatch aromas segue into a palate of citrus peel and beeswax with some of the appealing bitterness that's part of the variety's personality. 2024-29



Trespiedras Fuentecén Unanimous Santa Cruz 2021

Cosecha (12.8%)

Located at the fresher, more mineral end of the Albillo Mayor spectrum, this comes from vines planted between 880 and 912 metres. White flower, wet stone and patisserie spice aromas are supported by flavours of green apple, beeswax and citrus zest and a chiselled, mouth-watering finish. 2026-35
